

Lessons/Practices on Public Ice

Effective December, 1 2018 – Applicable year-round (*unless otherwise specified*) to all Figure Skaters, Hockey Players, Pros and Coaches for lessons/trainings of any kind occurring at the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center.

In an effort to prioritize the enjoyment of the general public and ensure their safety during Public Ice Skating Sessions, the following rules and guidelines will be implemented and/or have been revised:

Training, Coaching, Lessons and/or Individual Practice of any kind:

- **Allowed** during any regularly scheduled 10:30am-1:30pm and/or 2-4pm Public session.
- **Not Allowed** during any 3-5pm, 6-8pm and/or 7-9pm Public session, or during any session added to the schedule specifically due to Holiday and/or school breaks.
- Group Lessons/Trainings and/or Team Practices are not permissible on any Public session (*including Freestyle, Stick 'n Puck and/or Drop-In Hockey*)
 - Exception: group birthday party lessons (*or similar*) which are coordinated directly through Ice Skating Coordinator and occur during 2-4pm sessions only.

Music

- **Working CHRC staff have control over music during all Public Ice Skating Sessions.**
- Pros/Skaters may play their music one-time/skater during regularly scheduled 10:30am-1:30pm sessions only.
- ***No Routine or practice music can be played during any 2-4pm, 3-5pm, 6-8pm and/or 7-9pm Public session.***
- Music during public sessions should be family-friendly, ongoing and non-repetitive.

Equipment Use

- The on-ice harness, buckets, cones, tires or similar training items may **NOT** be used for any purposes during:
 - Any 6-8pm and/or 7-9pm session.
 - Any 2-4pm and/or 3-5pm Public sessions, October through March.
 - Any Public session which has more than 50 people.

Both Freestyles and Public Ice Skating Schedules will indicate which sessions allow lessons/skating practice.
